### **Exmoor Neighbourhood Beat team LCN Report 11/06/2026**

Our apologies that we are not attending this evening's meeting due to shift pattern and scheduled neighbourhood visits with a partner agency.

Exmoor continues to be a low crime area with little reported crime since the last meeting. We have continued with our daily work addressing neighbour issues, safeguarding our communities and dealing with anti-social behaviour (mostly within properties). There has recently been some anti-social behaviour in the Dunster area. It is currently under investigation with efforts being made to identify and deal with the culprits. We are working well with partners including Housing and environmental health to tackle other incidents of anti-social behaviour in Dulverton and surrounding areas. A suspect who was involved in drive offs (failing to pay for fuel) at the service station, has been subsequently convicted at court. There has been a theft of property from a vehicle at Dunkery Beacon.

We have been working on various preventative crime reduction initiatives, including:

- Visits to campsites with information to remind visitors to remove valuables from their cars.
- Trailer marking at Cutcombe Market with 21 trailers marked
- Police pop ups in local villages in May with 14 cycles registered.

Our focus for the summer is to continue to engage with the community through village pop ups, Dunster Fair, Cutcombe Fete and visits to Cutcombe Market. All dates are advertised in the monthly newsletter and on the Exmoor beat page of the A & S website.
