We aim to inspire positive action that prioritises young people's needs. Our goal is to help ensure they can continue living and working on Exmoor, rather than feeling they need to leave the area.

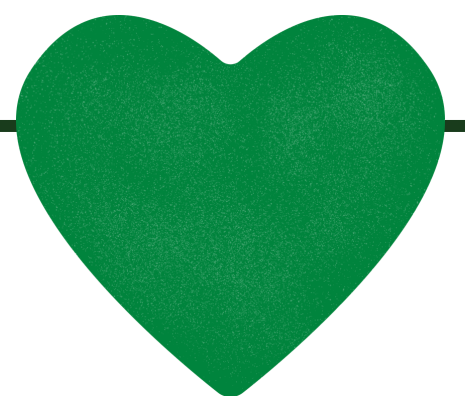


The King's Award for Voluntary Service

We are proud to have received The King's Award for Voluntary Service in 2024.

Other key achievements:

- Hosted 2 summits on Exmoor bringing together young people with ENPA, Council and housing association representatives to discuss housing problems & solutions
- Helped house young people who had previously been ruled out on technicalities



Self Build Homes

We set up a Self Build Group to support young people interested in building their own homes on Exmoor. EYV offers free guidance & helps self-builders overcome hurdles. We have also delivered self build tours & partnered with a local CIC offering self-build loans.



New projects

We are keen to support young people on Exmoor in new ways.

We are currently involved in fundraising for a Play Park in Luccombe and organising EYV's first Family Fun Day in Exford this September.

Engagement & partnerships
